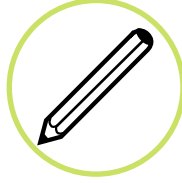
## 1 Equipment:



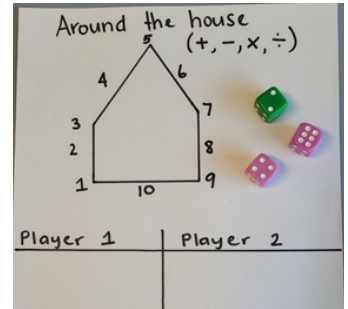
3 x dice

2 Pencils

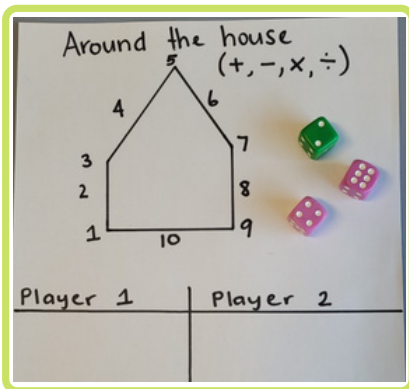

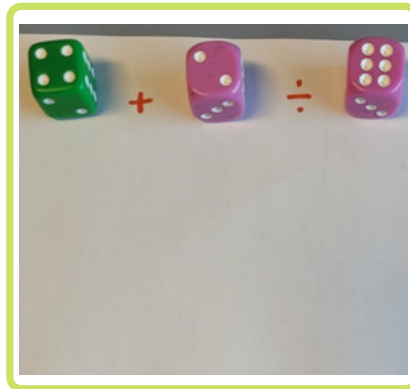

## 2 How to play:

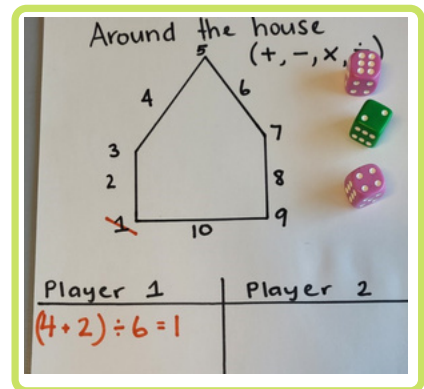
Each player takes turns rolling 3 dice. First to make it around the game board wins. On your turn, you get to choose how you use the numbers you rolled to make the targeted number using any of the 4 operations (+, -, x, ÷). To make the game easier only use 2 operations.



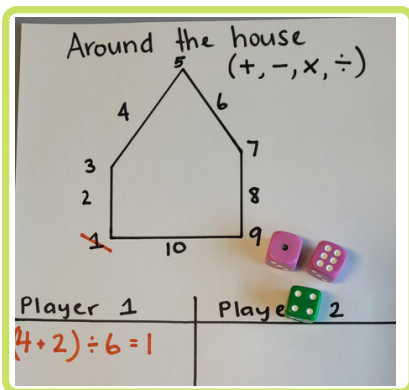
Player 1 rolls the dice.



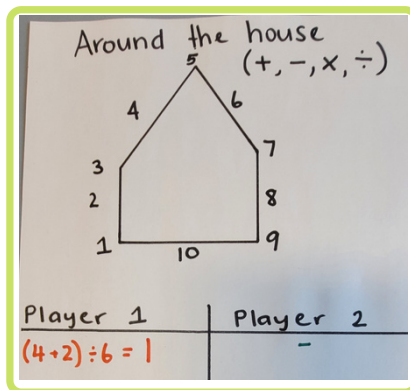
Use any combination of the 4 operations to try and make the number 1.



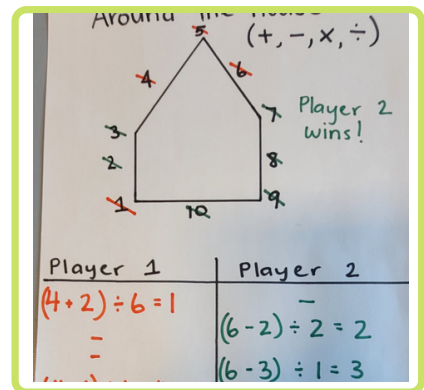
Record as a number sentence.



Player 2 repeats.



If you are unable to make the target number, player 1 will get to roll again.



The player who has crossed out the most numbers wins!
