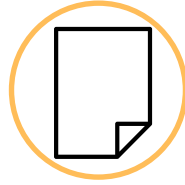

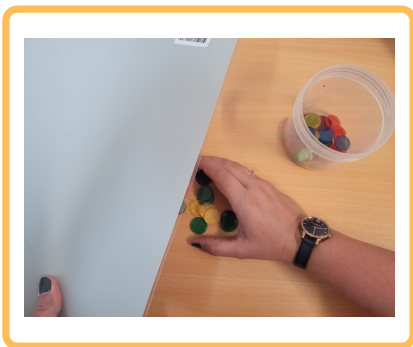

2 How to play:

Each player takes turns grabbing a handful of counters and hides them under paper. Players estimate how many counters are under the paper before counting them to see who was correct.



Player 1 grabs a handful of 'gold' (counters), puts them on the table and covers with paper.



Show the counters for 2 seconds and then recovers them.



Player 2 estimates how many counters are on the table.



Player 1 quickly organises the counters into a pattern (array or groups) that can be easily counted.



If Player 2's initial estimate was correct, they get the counters. If their initial estimate was incorrect, Player 1 gets the counters.



Player 2 then grabs a handful of the communal gold, and the roles are reversed.

The player with the most counters at the end wins.
