Cronulla Public School Sports Award Criteria

Junior & Senior Sporting Award

Each year at Cronulla Public School, 4 awards are presented to the Junior Boy and Girl champion and Senior Boy and Girl champion, for sporting achievement.

To receive an award students must fulfil the criteria as listed below. The student with the most points awarded for representing their school in sport will be given the trophy.

School P.S.S.A Teams and Competitive Knockout Teams

• 1 point for each selection into a competitive school PSSA team (PSSA Terms 2 and 4 only) or competitive School Knockout Team

Swimming/Athletics/Cross Country Carnivals

- 1 point for each event entered at Zone level
- 2 points for each event entered at Regional level
- 3 points for each event entered at State level
- 4 points for each event at National level

Individual Representative Teams

- 2 points for selection into a Cronulla Zone representative team
- 3 points for selection into a Sydney East representative team
- 4 points for selection into a State representative team

NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge Medal

The NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge Medal is given to recognise one student for excellence and involvement in school sport. The NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge Medal is intended to acknowledge a student for their outstanding:

- Commitment to fair play
- Achievement in their sporting discipline (as a participant/umpire/trainer/assistant and/or sports leader)
- Overall contribution to their school's weekly sporting program.
